

Things you will want to know.

1. Fees

\$475.00 - returning player with New Admiral brand uniform

\$575.00 - player or needing uniform

\$300.00 - training only

A \$275.00 deposit will be needed within 14 days of team assignment.

Remaining balance will be due August 15, 2013.

2. Season is from July – November/December

Training sessions 2–3 times per week

Teams will play in 2 tournaments (additional coach/registration fees will be required)

We will play most of our league games in Columbia & Charleston & Walterboro. We will have a few home games this year (hopefully) at USCB. USCB has been a great supporter, and has been encouraging!

3. Our teams enter SC Youth Soccer Association (SCYSA) & play in PMSL or SCSCCL leagues. These leagues are based out of Columbia, SC. We try when possible to schedule two games per Saturday to reduce travel. Depending on number of teams in league, usually 10 – 14 games per season.

4. We will have access to 2 fields at various times; Hilton Head Plantation & USCB (Bluffton). We are working with the county to secure an extra practice field in Bluffton. We must be flexible, but we will make it as accessible as possible for everyone.

5. You will receive a call or email from Southside Soccer Club by the end of the first week of June, 2014, discussing your child's try-out & placement.

6. The team ages are based on your child's age as of 08/01/14.
i.e., if your child is 12 years old as of 08/01/14, they will be U13.
If your child is 15 as of 08/01/14, they will be U16.
They can play up in age, obviously, they cannot play down.

7. Pre-Season summer conditioning (not mandatory but strongly recommended) will start on 06/18/14 @ Hilton Head Island HS track, 8:00 am – 9:30 am. There will be a one time, \$35.00 fee for the summer.
-Sessions will be held on M-W-F through the summer

8. Insurance: Your South Carolina Youth Soccer registration provides a Medical Insurance Policy, which is secondary medical insurance coverage subject to a \$1000.00 deductible per occurrence, in addition to your primary insurance deductible. This is included with your registration.
