

DRESS DOWN DAY RULES

All students must follow the dress down rules—Student may wear:

- ✓ Athletic shoes or school/dress shoes only!
- ✓ Socks—ankle socks are appropriate
- ✓ Short sleeve shirts; sweatshirts; long sleeve shirts
- ✓ Properly fitted shorts/athletic shorts (no short shorts—maximum 2 inches about the knee & no baggy shorts—cannot touch the middle of the shins)
- ✓ Skirts/dresses(maximum 2 inches above the knee)
- ✓ Jeans, cargo pants, khaki pants—NOT BAGGY

Students may **NOT** wear:

- Crocs, flip flops, high heels, boots/uggs, sandals/other open toed shoe or anything not listed in the “may wear” section!
- Halter tops, tank tops, muscle shirts, sleeveless shirts
- Tight fitting clothes
- Clothes with improper language, messages or symbols
- No painted finger nails, additional earrings/facial rings or extreme hairstyles
- Anything that will be called into question—students should ask themselves, “Will Mr. Benning think this is appropriate?”

Remember—dress down days are a privilege, not a right! Students who the administration or teacher has determined to be dressed inappropriately will be required to change into a used uniform or the parent will be called to supply new clothing. These are suppose to be fun opportunities for students in the school—please follow the rules!
