

# UNIFORM INFORMATION FOR THE 2013-2014 SCHOOL YEAR

**Parents** ~ The Dress Code at St. Peter's Catholic School requires that students wear the prescribed school uniform every day (attached). If it is necessary to wear corrective shoes, please inform the school office.

**We are making some distinctive changes to our uniform policy and ask that you review the gender table carefully (most specifically for girls). All changes are in bold type.**

The Uniform Policy for the 2012-2013 school-year will be grandfathered for one year. If the khaki shorts still fit your daughters, they are permitted to wear them for the 2013-2014 school year. If they have outgrown them, please replace them with the items listed on the new policy.

All uniform pieces should be purchased at New South Shirts. Khaki pants and shorts, PE sweatpants and shorts from the retailer of your choice. Uniform pieces should be clean, in excellent condition, and replaced as wear occurs.

At all times, uniform pieces should be clean and in good repair. Please plan ahead and replace stained or torn items.

**Restrictions:**

Hair: Hair must be off the collar and above the ears and eyebrows. No shaggy cuts, hair designs/dye, or tails. No unusual fad cuts which draw attention.
